I understand that the schools and school districts in which I do my teacher practicum/course assignment are subject to the *BC Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* (the “Act”).

I understand that in accordance with the Act that the privacy of students must be protected at all times and that any identifying personal information, including photographs, film, and student work, of students cannot be used without written permission.

Unless I have received signed consent from the student and/or the student’s legal guardian in accordance with the practicum school’s/district’s policy, I agree not to use, or post on the Internet, any images (photographic, film or other) and/or samples of student work that may identify a particular student or group of students for any purpose including to enhance my Professional e-Portfolio.

I understand that without the appropriate signed consent, I can only post non-identifying images to my Professional e-Portfolio for the purposes of UBC presentation, for employment seeking, and as an on-going record of my own professional development.

I am aware that if I breach this agreement that I may be subject to student discipline.
